

Let's talk Money

How All Access Holidays are financed

"Does the NDIS pay for my holidays?"

... is by far the question we get asked the most, when clients contact us for the first time



Clearly, there is confusion around exactly what the NDIS will pay for and what it will not pay for. So, we wanted to give some clarity on this by giving you a few examples of how the payments work with regards to holidays.

The NDIS will pay for all "reasonable" and "necessary" supports. It will not cover things such as food, accommodation or entertainment. In practical terms this means that the NDIS will pay for the care/support that you require whilst you are on holiday. However, the costs that are not associated with the care will need to be paid for privately. The NDIS will not pay for flights to destinations; the cost of the flights is to be paid for, separately.

It's important to bear in mind that everyone has different support needs and requirements. The amount that All Access Holidays will invoice the NDIS for support needs could be different to the amount we will invoice the NDIA for a client with higher support needs, therefore, drastically changing the amount you have to contribute to your holiday.

Example 1:

John Smith wishes to go to the Gold Coast with All Access Holidays and the cost of the all-inclusive holiday is \$4900. John is quite independent and requires minimal assistance, his support needs would be classed as a ratio of 1 carer to 4 clients (1:4). John has been transitioned over the NDIS and wants to know how much they will pay and how much he will have to cover privately. To work this out, we will tally up how much care and support John requires in terms of care hours, and then invoice the NDIA accordingly. For John's care needs, the total amount invoiced to the NDIA would be \$2,083. Meaning that John would have the remaining amount of \$2,817 to pay for privately. On our holidays, this fee includes accommodation, food, entertainment and transport, except for flights.


Example 2:

Jane Smith also wants to go to the Gold Coast with All Access Holidays. Jane requires some help with personal care, dressing, and meal assistance. Jane's support needs would be classed as 1 Carer to 2 clients (1:2). As in John's case, we will tally up how much care and support Jane requires, in terms of hours in line with the NDIS price guide. For Jane's care needs, the total amount invoiced to the NDIA would be \$3,420, leaving the outstanding amount for Jane to cover. In comparison, Jane's personal contribution would be significantly lower than John's, even though they are on the exact same holiday with All Access Holidays.

So, "Does the NDIS pay for my holiday?", technically, 'no'. But the NDIS will pay for the care that you receive whilst on holiday. But regardless, as the examples demonstrate, every person is different. Sometimes the care work is quite extensive, so the cost of the holiday will in some cases be met by the NDIS to a large extent.

- We will then email you all the necessary paperwork, which includes an
 Expression of Interest form. Once you have returned the filled in form to us,
 a Deposit of 25% is due, which then secures your spot on the holiday.
- The full payment is due 60 days prior to departure for domestic holidays, and 120 days for international travel.
- We will then make appropriate arrangements for your support and transportation needs.



By paying your deposit you are indicating your acceptance of these terms and conditions and a legally binding agreement is formed between AAH and you.

These terms and conditions can only be varied by agreement between AAH and you.

2. Our Services

AAH takes people with disabilities on holidays around Australia and overseas. It is a condition of all international bookings that the Client holds a valid passport at the time of paying the deposit to AAH. AAH is a service provider for the purposes of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 ("the Consumer Law").

We provide holiday packages planned by us that include:

- Booking accommodation
- Provision of all means, snacks and non-alcoholic beverages
- Booking your air transport (the cost of which is not included in our fees)
- All excursions and transfers booked and paid for
- Entertainment and activities included in your itinerary
- All-day care and support
- Over-night support can be arranged for an additional cost
- A photo album/calendar of your trip

We also provide tailored holidays for small groups. We will prepare a quote and itinerary which will stipulate the holiday inclusions based upon the Client needs. If something is not included in a tailored itinerary, it is excluded.

Our services are only available where we can accommodate Clients' care needs and provide a safe and pleasant experience for all travelling Clients. AAH retains the discretion to decline to offer services for this reason.

3. Exclusions

The following expenses are not included in our price:

- Cost of air travel
- Souvenirs and miscellaneous purchases
- Travel insurance
- Travel to the holiday meeting destination, unless separately arranged with us

4. Places are not guaranteed

Upon lodging your *Expression of Interest Form* with us, we will register your interest in a particular holiday. Some holidays may require a minimum number of Clients to proceed. If the holiday you are interested in does not proceed, we will work with you to either transfer the holiday or refund any deposit paid.

5. All-day care and support services

AAH will provide care and support to all Clients during the trip during waking hours. This includes:

- Assistance with showering and dressing
- Administering of non-invasive medication
- Supervision and assistance during the day

Over-night support can be arranged for an additional cost and includes:

- "Active Care", where the Client requires care during the night, a carer will stay awake the entire night to provide care for the Client.
- "Inactive Care", where the Client may require care during the night, a carer will be available to assist the Client during the night but is able to sleep.

Active Care is required where the Client requires more than 4 attendances during a night or requires care of more than one hour during the night.

Personal care services do not include the administering of invasive medical treatment (e.g. injections). Nurses can be arranged to attend the holiday with individual Clients at an additional cost.

6. Variations and Cancellations

To the extent permitted by law, cancellation charges apply to the Client and any travelling companion where a holiday is cancelled. The following cancellation fees apply, in addition to any third-party expenses that have been paid on the Client's behalf:

We will accept requests for transfers to a different holiday and accommodate such requests where it is practicable to do so, however transfer requests are not guaranteed and may result in a cancellation of the original holiday.

7. Payment and Pricing

- Prices are scaled depending upon individual client care needs
- AAH will provide the Client with a personalised quote
- Flights will be booked at least 30 days prior to departure, we will confirm the cost of flights within this time
- We require a deposit of 25% of the price to secure your booking
- Payment must be made in full, 60 days prior to the departure date
- Payment may be made by way of electronic funds transfer, cheque or credit card
- There may be additional expenses that Clients incur while travelling.
 This includes, but is not limited to, out of pocket expenses such as incidentals and souvenirs. Such costs are separate to those paid to AAH.

- Clients may bring cash to the maximum value of \$100.00. On request, we will administer your cash amount for you and assist you with purchases. All purchase / expenditure receipts are kept and provided to the Client (or a nominated person) by the end of the holiday.
- AAH will invoice the Client for any additional costs incurred by the Client during the trip. This may include additional costs such as laundry services, taxi rides, emergency services, damage to property, or active night services that were required but not previously booked. The Client acknowledges that AAH may use third party collection agencies to recover any funds owing by the Client to AAH and that the Client will be required to pay the costs incurred by AAH in recovering any amounts owing to it by the Client.

8. Refunds

- AAH will provide refunds in accordance with the Competition and Consumer Act 2010.
- Refunds are not provided for a 'change of mind'.
- The Client acknowledges that services booked through third party providers (such as airlines and accommodation) are subject to the cancellation policies of the provider, and the Client's right to a refund is dependent upon that provider's terms.

9. Image Use

- Photographs and filming will be taken during your travel with AAH so that
 we can provide you with a photo album/calendar at the end of your trip.
 Your photograph may also appear in the albums of your travel companions,
 for example, if we take group photographs or video.
- You authorise AAH to include your image in the photo albums of other travel companions and to use your image in both print and/or electronic means for our own promotional purposes. This includes future brochures and digital media, including our website and other external pages, such as social media channels, including Facebook, Twitter, Instagram & Linkedin.
- I waive any interest that I may have in the copyright to my Image now or at any future time and acknowledge that I am not entitled, nor shall in the future be entitled, to receive any payment or consideration in respect of it and agree to make no claim against AAH for any payments for the Publication of my Image.
